**Tournament Rules: Singles, Doubles and Team Events**

1. Participants must be sanctioned members of USBC Youth Leagues of the Peoria Association and must present their league sanction cards at check-in time.
2. Bantam teams shall consist of 4 members; all other teams will be 5 members. All teams will bowl in the age division of the oldest bowler.
3. A bowler may enter and bowl more than once in the team event, but at least 2 members of the team must be changed if they stay in the same division. Multiple participation is permitted, but the same entry may only cash once. Division will be determined by the age of the oldest bowler in Doubles and Team events.
4. The All-Events score will be based on the bowler's score from the FIRST TIME they bowl in the Team, Doubles & Singles.
5. If any participant is found ineligible under the rules of this tournament, the entire team will be disqualified.
6. Reservations will be accepted only from sanctioned leagues. The date requested will be held until November 17, 2009. If monies and completed entries are not in by that date, the tournament manager may cancel the reservations and fill with completed entries. No reserved entries will be accepted unless accompanied by Cash, Check or Money Order for the total fees listed on the entry form. Please do not send cash thru the mail.
7. **NO ENTRY FEE WILL BE REFUNDED.**
8. The tournament reserves the right to refuse entry into the tournament.
9. Entrants will use their highest league average determined by the following order (9 or more games).
  - A. Highest league average for end of the previous winter season.
  - B. If A does not apply, highest league average for end of the previous summer season.
  - C. If current average is 10 pins higher than previous average, bowler will use current average as of November 1.
  - D. If A or B does not apply, highest league average of 9 or more games as Nov. 1, 2009.
  - E. Entrants not having an average as of November 1 may enter using their highest league average as of Tournament time (minimum of 9 games). A league coach shall verify all averages.
  - F. Bowlers without an average will bowl scratch. Please send a copy of all league averages
10. **Please send a copy of all league averages**
11. All play will be on a handicap basis – 90% of 220.
12. All stated awards will be made on handicap scores.
13. **AWARDS:** 1<sup>st</sup> Place Bantam and Prep handicap teams, Doubles, Singles and All Events for Girls & Boys age 11 & under will receive trophies or plaques. Junior and Major/Senior 1<sup>st</sup> Place handicap teams, Doubles, Singles and All Events for Boys & Girls age 12 & over will receive Scholarship Money.
14. 2<sup>nd</sup> Place team event awards will only be given if 8 or more teams participate in a division.
15. Age divisions are determined by age as of August 1, 2009. Bantams-8 & under, Preps 9-11, Junior 12-14, Major/Senior 15-20.
16. Any appeal or protest concerning scoring shall be made in writing and submitted to the Peoria USBC Tournament Manager no later than 72 hours after the games have been played. This appeal or protest shall state briefly the grounds of the appeal or protest.
17. If a duly scheduled entrant is unable to bowl, a substitute will be allowed. All substitutes shall be accompanied by a properly signed average certification which must be reported to the Tournament Office 1 HOUR BEFORE the scheduled time of bowling by the team captain or league coach. Once a substitute is assigned, no changes may be made.
18. In case of disability after a game has started, a substitute, if available shall begin play with the score counting with the frame then being bowled.
19. **CHECK-IN IS 1 HOUR PRIOR TO THE SCHEDULED TIME TO BOWL. ENTRIES CLOSE 1 HOUR BEFORE EACH SQUAD.**
20. Any bowler or team arriving late, who has not been replaced by a substitute, shall begin play with the score counting with the frame being bowled.
21. No pacers will be permitted. NO tobacco, alcohol or headgear (USBC rules) will be permitted in the bowling area or on the concourse directly behind the bowlers. All electronic devices will be turned off.
22. In case of a tie for first place, the Tournament Manager will schedule a roll-off. Three games will be bowled to determine the winner.
23. No one will be permitted in the bowlers' area except tournament participants, tournament officials and the official scorekeepers.
24. Bowlers must be ready to bowl when it is their turn, or they will receive a zero for that frame.
25. Use of any foreign substance in the bowling area, such as talcum powder will not be permitted.
26. No eating or drinking in the bowlers' area.
27. All participants **MUST** wear bowling shoes.
28. USBC rules will apply if not covered in the above rules.
29. A person can qualify to participate in the State Tournament on more than one team.
30. After entries for the State Tournament are mailed, the Coach will make replacements. One original member of a team must be present to bowl in the State Tournament. **\*\*State Tournament is an open tournament – no qualifying necessary\*\***
