Rick started bowling at the Knights of Columbus downtown Peoria in 1977 and ended that season with a 146 average. As time rolled along he did get somewhat better ending last season with a 214 average. Rick has averaged 200 or better most of his bowling career with his highest average being 226.

He has bowled in the Bud Masters, all Knights of Columbus leagues, Checkmate, DuPont, Lon's 1 x 6, Calumet, Monday Nite 3 x 4, Monday Nite Mid-Way, Rosewood Classic and Thursday Nite Businessman's.

Some of the tournaments that Rick has bowled are 21 ABC/USBC National Tournaments, PBA True Value, CICBA, CIC, Tri-City Classic, Hoinke Classic, Eldorado Classic, Central Illinois Classic King Pin, Maple Lanes, Brothers/Brother-In-Law Tournament, Illinois State Bowling Tournament, City Association Tournaments held in Peoria, Pekin, Bloomington, Atlanta and Lincoln.

Rick's accomplishments include 13 - 300 games, 3 - 299 games, 3 - 800 series with the highest being 837, 1 merit award, 5 Peoria City Tournament titles, 1 Bloomington City title, 1991 Knights of Columbus National Tournament singles and all events titles, and 2009 Knights of Columbus National Tournament doubles and all events titles.
