

RULES

TOTAL FEES MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY FORM. Adults and Juveniles-\$25.00 (Bowling \$7, Tournament \$11.00 (includes pictures) Prize \$7 Optional Singles -\$5 (Tournament \$1, Prize \$4) Prize Fees of Adults and Juveniles (\$7) and Singles (\$4) is NONREFUNDABLE (100% of all prize fees collected will be awarded). If you bowl more than once with the same partner – fee is \$20.00 no pictures provided after first time.

All USBC bowlers and all USBC Youth bowlers are eligible to enter this moral support tournament with award recognition automatically extended. Non-USBC members may qualify for award recognition by paying associate dues before competition. The associate dues are \$21.00 per Adult and \$14.00 per Youth.

Entrants must use highest USBC average of the previous season of at least 12 or more games. Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own average. If the current average at time of participation for 12 or more games are 15 pins or more higher than the prior season's average, the current average must be used. Failure to use the proper average or to make a correction prior to completion of the first game of the series shall disqualify the score if submitted average is lower than actual average or prize winnings will be based on the submitted average if higher. **Those without a 2008-2009 average must use highest USBC average of at least 12 games in the past 5 years at time of participation in the current Sisters Tournament. If they do not have an average - 150 will be given to Adults and 8 times the age of the youth will be used. Tournament management reserves the right to re-rate an entrant prior to the start of competition.** Previous tournament winnings need not be reported.

There will be separate divisions for Juveniles (both entrants must be 19 years of age or younger) and Adult/Juvenile (one entrant must be 19 years of age or younger). These divisions are not eligible for cash, but are eligible for scholarships or trophies.

There will be separate division for Sister-in-Law. All participants in this division must have a bonafide Sister-in-law relationship at the time of participation in the tournament.

Walk-in entries will be accepted until Sunday February 28, 2010 if openings are available. Additional squads may be added during the course of the tournament as deemed necessary by Tournament management, but no squad shall be added after the last advertised squad time.

All Prize Fees will be returned 100% Prize ration 1 in 10

Multiple participation will be allowed but you may only cash one time with the same sister.
